Q&A: WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE?

- Past NetWorked convening participants, presenters
- NetWorked for Change conference attendees
- Project teams of eligible NetWorked participants may choose up to two new-to-NetWorked organizations to
 participate on Round 2 grants (new-to-NetWorked meaning organizations that have not previously participated).
 Note: Lead Applicants must be existing NetWorked participants; not new-to-NetWorked participants.
- Those whose organizations are located outside of Kansas are not eligible to participate at this time
- Eligible organizations with documented participation are included on a list that serves as the eligible pool of participants
- Round 1 awardees are eligible to participate in Round 2
- Sponsoring organizations and NetWork Kansas are not on the list



Q&A: COULD SOMEONE LOOK OVER MY APPLICATION TO MAKE SURE I COMPLETED IT CORRECTLY?

- NetWorked and NetWork Kansas is happy to answer questions about the application but cannot edit applications;
 this may introduce an unfair advantage
- To ensure equal opportunity for all applicants, NetWorked, NetWork Kansas and/or sponsor organizations' staff members are not able to recommend or, in any way, influence the coordination of project teams or project types



Q&A: Are these project-based Grants?

- Yes, the eligible project types are:
 - **Community Input** A surveying or community conversation project to solicit public input on a matter relevant to the selected impact area
 - **Community Outreach** An event that involves gathering the public to discuss and engage in activities that are relevant to the selected impact area
 - **Community Service** A project that engages volunteers and others to benefit an effort, initiative or goal relevant to the selected impact area
 - Marketing digital and/or hardcopy campaigns to educate the public on a matter relevant to the selected impact area



Q&A: There are 3 roles that need to be covered, but the 3 roles can be covered by 2 partners in 2 partnering organizations, right? i.e. We don't have to have 3 partnering organizations.

 Project teams need to have at least three different members; each member organization is to represent a different sector.



Q&A: Can one application serve multiple entities or does it just need to be focused on one in particular?

• This grant effort intends for one organization to represent one sector to served on one project team to submit one application.
